Invasive lobular carcinoma - This type of breast cancer accounts for about 15% of cases. It originates in the breast's milk-producing lobules. It can spread to the breast's fatty tissue and other places in the body. Medullary, mucinous, and tubular carcinomas - These slow-growing breast cancers account for about 8% of breast cancers.
