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### Left Hand Writing Skills A

Left-handed kids write from right to left, their hand covers the page thereby obscuring the view of what they have just written. Also, as the left-handed kid drags hand across the freshly written letters, smudges the writing.

### How To Improve Handwriting Skills For Adults That Are Left ...

The short version of how one can tell this was written by someone with minimal special skills in teaching left-handers: the author suggests writing on a white board for additional practice, which is a good tip for right-handers ONLY as left handed writing on a white board erases the text as you go.

### Tips for Teaching Your Left Handed Child Handwriting | Jen ...

Use softer leaded pencils e.g. 2B rather than HB to reduce writing pressure. Try pens and pencils with a differentiated barrel. Grasp. Ideally left-handers should hold the pen or pencil 2-3cm from the point to enable them to see round their fingers and avoid "hooking" with the writing hand or adopting and awkward neck posture when writing.

A left-handed child should grasp the pencil about an inch and a half above the tip. It will allow them to see what they're writing and help them avoid the dreaded "lefty hook." If you know an adult who is left-handed, you may have noticed something referred to as the lefty hook. Their wrists curve as they write and it almost looks painful.

7) Teach left handed writers to place their paper to the left of their body so they can see what they're writing. When they finish writing across an entire line, their hand should either be slightly to the left of their midline or just in front of it.

### Tips for Teaching Left Handed Children to Write

How you position your paper depends on what your dominant writing hand is. If you're right-handed, go ahead and use a left-angled or more vertical page position, but if you're a lefty, you'll likely benefit from angling your paper more to the right.

However, if you use your left hand (try this), as you write from left to right, your left hand tends to move over and cover the words that you have already written, so that you can't read them! If you are writing with ink that can smudge, this is an added problem. Your left hand moves across the page in a pushing motion.

Adjust the shape of your hand. Your pen or pencil should be held between your thumb and index and (optional) middle fingers. The end of the writing utensil should rest against either the web of your hand or against the knuckle of your index finger.
