Long Time-Exposures (M Mode Only) Select the following shutter speeds for long time-exposures of moving lights, the stars, night scenery, or fireworks. Bulb (A): The shutter remains open while the shutter-release button is held down. To prevent blur, use a tripod or an optional wireless remote controller or remote cord (0Other Accessories).

Long Time-Exposures (M Mode Only)

Exposure times of anywhere between 1/4th of a second to multiple minutes is common with long exposure photography. It goes without saying that you're not able to get a sharp handheld image when using a shutter speed of 30 seconds. By using a tripod you make it possible to work with such long exposures and capture great, sharp images.

Essential Equipment for Long Exposure Photography

Long exposure means setting shutter speeds to a higher than normal time, although there isn't a defined time setting as to what constitutes long exposure as opposed to short exposure shots (or even medium if you want to get more detailed), typically we are talking about photo's that are anything more than 10 seconds or so.

How to Setup Your Camera for Long Exposure Photography ...

A tripod is essential for long exposure photography. As I pointed out, anything below 1/60th of a second will create blurriness in your images. Long exposures tend to create photographs from exposures as long as 30 seconds. Some could even take hours.

A Beginners Guide to Shooting Long Exposure Photography

Turn the camera's mode dial to Manual or Bulb shooting mode and use a slow shutter speed (5-30 seconds) for a longer exposure. The longer the exposure, the mistier the water appears. Use your camera's self-timer or a cable release to take the photo with absolutely no blurring. Don't use flash because it could ruin the effect in the image.

Survey your collection of photos, and I'd bet that most will have been taken at 1/30th of a second or faster. Usually, we want to freeze any action, getting as sharp an image as possible.Other times, however, we might want to purposefully use long exposures for creative images.

1) Go to manual mode and select "bulb" for shutter speed. 2) Change the release mode to remote. 3) Go into the "Shooting Menu", select "Remote Control Mode" and note the setting. 4a) If in "Delayed remote" or "Quick-response remote" mode, begin the exposure by pressing the remote button once .

How can I take long exposures using a Nikon D7000 with ...

Rather than change shutter speed manually between each shot, try setting the shutter speed to Bulb. Available in M (manual) exposure mode, this option records an image for as long as you hold down the shutter button. So just take a series of images, holding down the button for different lengths of time for each shot.
