Global death penalty figures Amnesty International recorded 657 executions in 20 countries in 2019, a decrease of 5% compared to 2018 (at least 690). This is the lowest number of executions that Amnesty International has recorded in at least a decade. Most executions took place in China, Iran, Saudi Arabia, Iraq and Egypt – in that order.

Amnesty recorded at least 2,591 death sentences imposed in 53 countries worldwide in 2017, down 17% from the reported 3,117 death sentenced imposed in 55 countries in 2016. The U.S. ranked 11th in death sentences imposed. Amnesty reported that at least 21,919 people were known to be on death rows around the world at the end of 2017.

The World Day Against the Death Penalty, held each year on the 10 October, is an important moment to shine a light on the continuing injustice of the death penalty. When Amnesty International started campaigning against the death penalty in 1977, only 16 countries had abolished it.

According to Amnesty International, as of July 2015, 101 countries have abolished the death penalty for all crimes in law, while 140 countries have abolished the death penalty in law or practice. At least 607 executions were carried out worldwide in 2014, a decrease of almost 22% compared to the figures recorded for 2013.
